**Please answer the following True-False questions. Please ask the leader for help if you need it.**

- T F 1. Jesus perfectly fulfilled all of the Old Testament prophecies (predictions) about the coming Savior.
- T F 2. After the flood, God gave the rainbow as a reminder that he will protect us.
- T F 3. Even a person who lives a good life is guilty of sin, of rebelling against God.
- T F 4. Since God is holy and since all people are sinful, no one can do enough good works to meet God's demands.
- T F 5. God promised Abraham that ALL PEOPLE would be blessed through the coming Messiah, one of Abraham's descendents.
- T F 6. The real (the spiritual) children of Abraham are those who believe in Jesus.
- T F 7. At the time of Moses, the death of an innocent lamb was a picture that the sacrifice of the innocent Lamb, Jesus, would bring an escape from eternal death.
